Fine Arts Festival Rules:

Please Note: We are doing all we can to keep this event socially distanced and safe as according to the CDC guidelines. We want to continue to encourage our young local musicians during these difficult times. Preventative measures will be taken to ensure that students will stay healthy and safe to the best of our abilities.

The goal of the Women's Century Club Fine Arts Festival is to encourage classically trained musicianship and theatrical performance in three age categories:

Adagio: For musicians aged 10-12. Memorization of piece is encouraged.

Con Brillo: For musicians aged 13-15. Memorization of piece is required.
Vocalists may sing Art Songs, Operetta or Musical Theatre in this category.

Vivace: For musicians aged 16-18. Memorization of piece is required.
Vocalists may sing Art Songs, Musical Theatre, Operetta, or Operatic arias in this category.

Each student will prepare a short work and receive a personalized Master Class from a professional musician. Written comments and scores will be provided to teachers via E-mail.

We are uncertain if we will be able to have a semifinal. Please check back in on the website closer to the performance. Winning contestants will be invited to the Bravo Concert.

At the Bravo Concert, we have traditionally awarded fine arts camp scholarships. We are hoping to continue this tradition. These performance opportunities are essential to the development of young musicians.

Music selections of Classical, Art Songs and Musical Theatre may be prepared for Adjudication. Pop music is not allowed in this competition. Original Compositions are the only exception, and may be on any instrument, and in any genre. Individuals and groups may prepare a selection not exceeding 5 minutes for a Master Class for 15 minutes for \$25 or selection not exceeding 10 minutes or an Extended Masterclass of 20 minutes for \$30.

Each student must scan and email a copyrighted version of their score, with every 5th measure numbered. You can use the Pro-Scanner app on your phone, or other photo to PDF apps. Accompanists must play from copyrighted material. Original Compositions are the only exception, but still need to include a written score or chart (lyrics and chord symbols) for their adjudicator.

All students must be the age within their category by the registration deadline of October 10, 2020.

This is a family-friendly venue. Please choose material appropriate for the venue.

To keep our community safe, at the time of performance, the only people allowed in the room will be the performer, accompanist, adjudicator, and one parent or guardian. Each participant must wear a mask while in the building.

Currently, we are planning a socially distanced and Zoom hybrid to minimize risk of spread. Vocalists will not be masked during performance but are encouraged to wear their mask while entering and exiting their performance venue. Students will enter the building one at a time 10 minutes before their performance slot. Each musician must arrive at their designated venue prepared, warmed up, and ready to play.
